The Tapestry Program’s first objective is to welcome parishioners to the Sunday Liturgy, as well as invite active participation in that Liturgy. The Tapestry Program’s other two goals are to encourage involvement in parish ministries and committees and to increase the amount and consistency of the offertory contributions which sustain the parish infrastructure.

By weaving together these donations of time, talent and treasure, the Tapestry Program makes it possible to maintain and develop the parish’s spiritual and communal environment.
